Brief description of the current situation which is to be targeted by the earmarked donation; list of required items covered by the donation; prospected sustainable use of the donation

Malawi faces serious challenges in the health sector. Malawi is struggling with an increase in communicable and non-communicable diseases. The incidence of non-communicable diseases is on the rise. We estimate that 33% of adults aged 25-64 years suffer from hypertension and 5.6% are diabetic. In order to prevent non-communicable diseases such as hypertension and diabetes, primary health care provision needs to be strengthened to detect the risks associated with these diseases early. The provision of primary health care is extremely difficult, mainly due to the lack of health capacity. Health units equipped with diagnostic and treatment equipment could solve this problem, which will provide innovative solutions to strengthen Malawi's health system. This solution can improve the health situation in Malawi by providing accessible, quality care to the population that needs it most. Equipment for clinical training will enhance the professional skills of healthcare personnel and significantly help to address the shortage of staffing capacities.

Kamuzu Central Hospital in Lilongwe plays a vital role in providing healthcare services to Malawi's population. We would be deeply grateful if we could acquire the necessary medical equipment and clinical simulators to provide basic diagnostics and medical care to the residents of Malawi.
