3. Description of Problem, Suggested Intervention and List of Items

Brief description of the current situation which is to be targeted by the earmarked donation; list of required items covered by the donation; prospected sustainable use of the donation

As a result of Russia's ongoing military aggression, Ukraine's energy infrastructure has suffered massive destruction. Air strikes and missile attacks have severely damaged both generation facilities and critical nodes of the transmission and distribution networks. In many regions, particularly in the east and center of the country, energy supply to residential

areas, hospitals, and public services remains unstable due to a shortage of functional high-voltage transformers.

One of the most pressing technical issues is the failure or destruction of high-voltage transformers, which are essential for converting and distributing electricity from national transmission grids to regional and local consumers. Without them, entire urban districts, hospitals, water treatment facilities, and emergency shelters remain without reliable power. Their replacement is not only vital to basic infrastructure restoration but also to the survival and well-being of the civilian population.

In response to this need, the project foresees the supply of 3 power transformers, which could be manufactured by a certified and reputable European supplier of electrical equipment. These transformers are intended for immediate deployment in:

- Kharkiv to restore capacity at a major distribution substation serving densely populated areas;
- Ternopil to stabilize power supply to critical infrastructure, including hospitals and schools;
- **Khmelnytskyi** to ensure reliable voltage transformation in a mixed-use zone supporting residential and industrial facilities.

Each transformer will supply power to residential housing, critical municipal infrastructure (e.g. pumping stations, hospitals), and social institutions that are currently relying on unstable or emergency sources of electricity.

Technical specifications of the equipment (summarized):

- High-voltage oil-immersed power transformer,
- Nominal voltage: 35/10 kV,
- Rated power: 4 000 KVA,

- Nominal capacity: specified individually per site,
- Complete with technical documentation, including installation instructions, maintenance guidelines, and compliance certificates.

Transformers are:

- Brand new, never used, not repaired or refurbished;
- Supplied with transportation, customs clearance, installation and commissioning included;
- Delivered in protective enclosures for **outdoor use**, ready for connection by local energy companies;
- Covered by a manufacturer's warranty for 24 months from the date of shipment.

As an alternative, if necessary, the applicant is prepared to consider acquiring simplified transformer configurations, which could reduce unit cost. This would allow redirecting

a portion of project funds to an additional, socially significant purpose — namely, the repair and modernization of elevator equipment in multi-storey buildings. This measure aligns with the national policy at advancing barrier-free accessibility and equal opportunities. The applicant has submitted a separate commercial proposal for this component and is ready to provide further justification upon request.

The supply and installation of these units will contribute to decentralized energy stability and serve as a model for effective crisis response using international cooperation. The project fully aligns with Ukraine's national goals for energy security, efficient infrastructure recovery, and support to war-affected communities.

Data protection information

The following information is provided on the basis of Article 13 of the GDPR1:
