3. Description of Problem, Suggested Intervention and List of Items

Beit Jala Governmental Hospital was established in 1908 by a Swedish ophthalmologist, and it transitioned into the "Swedish Hospital" in 1947, offering general surgery, pediatrics, and obstetrics. Nowadays, the hospital is the primary healthcare provider for approximately 220,000 individuals residing in the Bethlehem governorate. Its scope of activities includes providing essential healthcare services to a wide population, focusing on emergency care, specialized treatments, and maternal and child health.

Unfortunately, due to limited resources, the hospital is currently facing a shortage of critical medical equipment. These essential tools are vital for the diagnosis, treatment, and care of the hospital's patients. Without these devices, the hospital is not in the position to provide the level of care that the local community deserves.

A donation of medical equipment from the Czech Republic would contribute significantly to the hospital's mission to deliver high-quality medical care, and to address the community's needs in challenging circumstances.

The earmarked delivery of medical devices will enhance the hospital's service delivery capacity, improve patient outcomes, and strengthen its ability to handle complex medical cases.

The required items include the following:

- 1 Orthopedic Operation Table
- 1 Surgical Operation Table
- 1 Table Top Autoclave Machine
- 1 Transport Incubator
- 2 Electrosurgical Units with Trolley
- 10 Patient Stretchers
- 2 Surgical Sets
- 2 Sets of Operation Theatre Equipment

Data protection information

The following information is provided on the basis of Article 13 of the GDPR¹:

I.
