3. Description of Problem, Suggested Intervention and List of Items

Our hospital has a well-established and active Obstetrics and Gynaecology Department, with a high volume of deliveries monthly. A significant proportion of newborns require specialized neonatal care, including Level I-III neonatal services, as well as initial stabilization prior to referral to tertiary centres.

Currently, we have the space but the hospital lacks equipment and staff, which results in:

- Limited ability to manage common and preventable neonatal conditions
- Increased referrals to external tertiary centres, often under suboptimal stabilization
- Restrictions on accepting higher-risk pregnancies during the antenatal period
- Increased burden on families due to transfers and delays in care

Our Goals

- Provide safe care for neonates requiring basic and intermediate neonatal support
- Manage common neonatal conditions locally
- Stabilize critically ill neonates before referral to tertiary NICUs
- Improve maternal care by expanding acceptance of moderate-risk pregnancies
- Strengthen neonatal resuscitation and post-natal care services

Data protection information

The following information is provided on the basis of Article 13 of the GDPR¹:
