5. Description of Problem, Suggested Intervention and List of Items

Brief description of the current situation which is to be targeted by the earmarked donation, and list of required items covered by the donation.

The city of Samarra (Salah al-Deen Governorate) and its surrounding areas were among the most devastating battlegrounds of the war against the Islamic State in Iraq between 2014 and 2017. After the city was liberated in October 2017, most public infrastructure remained heavily damaged or completely destroyed. Samarra General Hospital – the only facility with surgical and obstetric departments serving more than 400,000 inhabitants (including returnees and internally displaced persons) – was used as a field hospital during the fighting and suffered direct hits. To this day, the building has been only partially repaired, thanks solely to local resources and sporadic donations from international organisations.

In 2025 – eight years after liberation – the healthcare situation remains critical. The hospital has functional operating theatres and highly skilled Iraqi medical staff (many doctors trained in Europe or Baghdad), but virtually no disposable medical supplies for planned (elective) surgeries.

Because of the lack of supplies, these patients are either turned away or referred to Baghdad (200 km away), which most families cannot afford financially or logistically. As a result, many of them live with chronic pain or in direct danger of losing their lives for years.

In 2024, Samarra General Hospital performed only 18 % of the planned surgical procedures compared to 2013 (the last full year before the war). The rest have been postponed indefinitely.

The World Health Organization (WHO) and the Iraqi Ministry of Health have ranked Salah al-Deen Governorate among the three most underfunded and most needy regions in the entire country.
