3. Description of Problem, Suggested Intervention and List of Items

The city of Erbil has experienced massive population growth in the last decade, not least due to the influx of refugees and other migrants from areas in Iraq (and Syria) destroyed during the war against Daesh (2014 – 2017). Public services infrastructure often struggles to keep pace.

The Erbil Maternity Teaching Hospital remains to this day the only specialized governmental facility for obstetrics and gynaecology / maternal care in the city, serving the majority of the population of Erbil and the surrounding areas. Due to the lack of alternative services, the hospital consistently receives patient numbers far beyond its designed capacity, creating a significant strain on its infrastructure, medical resources, and staff.

Given this heavy and continuous demand, the hospital urgently requires additional support to expand its capacity, upgrade equipment, and strengthen its workforce. Such support is necessary to ensure the delivery of safe, reliable, and efficient maternal and women's health care for the community.
