Akyl AI

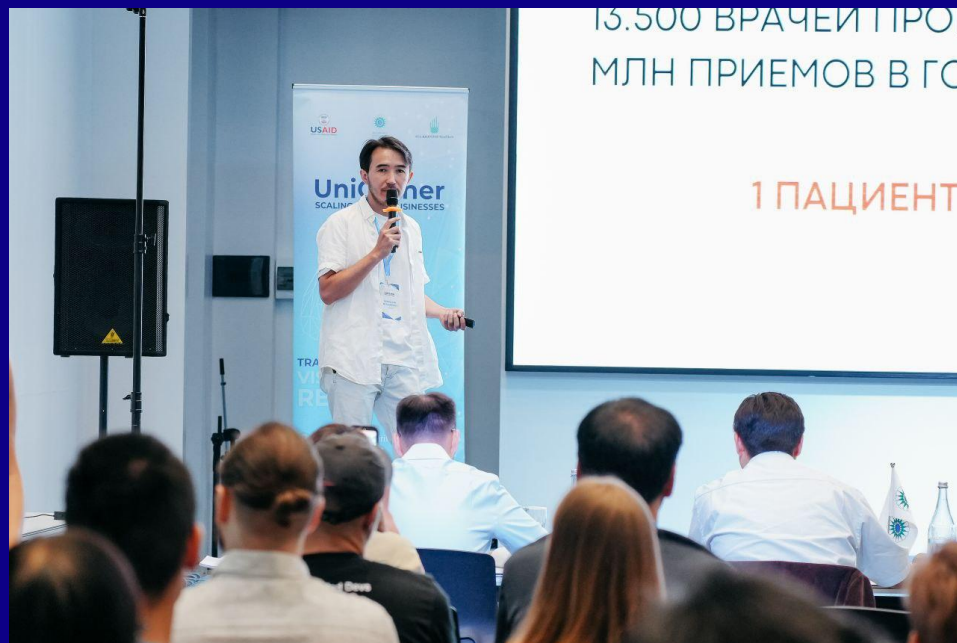
