3. Description of Problem, Suggested Intervention and List of Items

Ukraine's regional electricity distribution networks continue to operate under severe strain due to repeated missile and drone attacks, physical destruction of substations, and chronic overload of local grids. The Odesa and Dnipro regions, in particular, faces a critical shortage of distribution transformers needed to restore damaged infrastructure, stabilize voltage levels, and ensure reliable electricity supply for residential areas, industry, and critical facilities. With the 2026/2027 winter season approaching, the timely reinforcement of the regional grid has become an urgent priority for local operators.

The proposed project focuses on supplying 16 oil-immersed distribution transformers. These units are designed for high operational reliability, low energy losses, and stable performance under fluctuating load conditions. Their rapid installation capability allows distribution system operators to immediately strengthen vulnerable segments of the grid, replace equipment damaged by attacks, and increase reserve capacity in high-risk zones. The donation directly addresses the current deficit of essential distribution equipment in the Odesa and Dnipro regions and supports broader efforts to stabilize the southern Ukrainian energy system.

List of items covered by the donation:

- 2 × oil-immersed distribution transformer, 400kVA 10kV;
- 2 × oil-immersed distribution transformer, 630kVA 10kV;
- 4 × oil-immersed distribution transformer, 400kVA 6kV;
- 4 × oil-immersed distribution transformer, 630kVA 6kV;
- 2 × oil-immersed distribution transformer, 100kVA 6kV;
- 2 × oil-immersed distribution transformer, 1000kVA.

The donated transformers will be transferred to the cities administrations and sustainably used by the regional distribution system operators to restore damaged substations, reinforce overloaded grid segments, and reduce the risk of prolonged outages during peak demand periods. Their deployment will contribute to stabilizing electricity supply in the Odesa and Dnipro regions, improving resilience against future attacks, and supporting Ukraine's long-term efforts to modernize and strengthen its energy infrastructure.

Data protection information
